St. Paul writes,

"Therefore, my beloved, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord, because you know that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." (I Cor. 15:48)

The Stewardship Board would like to celebrate your labors, the work that you do outside of the church. Thus, beginning on the weekend of August 18th-19th, we are asking you to bring something in that represents your everyday work to be placed at the altar. These items will then be blessed on Labor Day weekend, and then you may take them home the following weekend. It will be a visual reminder of how we are called to use our everyday work to give glory to God.

The item should not be too valuable as we don't want to have someone take it, but something that has meaning to you about what you do and how you serve in the everydayness of your lives. We will have special tables around the altar for you to place them upon. You can simply put them there before or after worship.
