St. Paul writes,

*"Therefore, my beloved, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord, because you know that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." (I Cor. 15:48)*

The Stewardship Board would like to celebrate your labors, the work that you do outside of the church. Thus, beginning on the weekend of August 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup>, we are asking you to bring something in that represents your everyday work to be placed at the altar. These items will then be blessed on Labor Day weekend, and then you may take them home the following weekend. How we use our gifts and abilities outside the church reflects our calling to serve in Christ's name. We want to celebrate your work. We want to bless your work. We want you to feel God's blessings as you do your work.

My favorite verse of scripture is Genesis 12:2:

We want to help make sure that you realize you have been blessed so that you will be a blessing even in your work, especially in your work, as you share your gifts and your blessings with those around you. So bring in an item starting August 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup>, and then prepare for special blessings upon all of our labors on September 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>.
