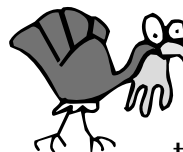
Sign up with Family & Friends to join us at Duncan's Corn Maze on Sunday, October 1st. This year, if you get lost, at least it won't be dark!
