UPDATE for LWR School Kit Supplies

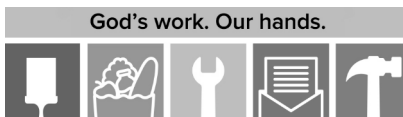
WOW!! Your generosity has been incredible.
