## Trinity is upgrading our software and giving platform!

We are moving from Shepherd's Staff (database) and Vanco (giving) to Pushpay, a tool that makes both easier to use and adds new ways for members to connect beyond Sunday mornings.

#### What this means for you:

- Pushpay will simplify online giving (one-time or recurring) through our new app or by text.
- You may still give in person with cash or check using an envelope.
