The Northeastern Pennsylvania (NEPA) Synod Assembly is the annual gathering of congregations, pastors, deacons, licensed lay ministers, and leaders to worship, conduct business, and discern our shared mission. As the synod's primary decision-making body, rostered ministers and elected lay voting members consider resolutions, elect leaders, and hear ministry updates.

In 2026, the Assembly will also include the election of a bishop, as voting members prayerfully discern and elect a bishop to serve a six-year term.
