From Pastor Jen...

Dear Trinity Family,

I reach out to you in this season of Easter and resurrection beginnings in a posture of humble gratitude. From Pastor Eileen...

Women of the Bible

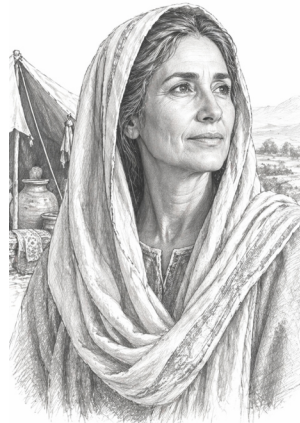
My dear siblings in Christ,

I thought it would be interesting to use the next few months as an opportunity to highlight some of the women of the Bible in my monthly column. While I will highlight what we know from the biblical text, I will also be reflecting on the way I connect with their experiences as women of faith.

Sarai/Sarah

Sarah is the first of four biblical matriarchs of the Hebrew scriptures. When we first meet Sarah, her name is Sarai. Genesis tells us that she was married to Abram (who later became Abraham) and was also his half-sister, a daughter of his father by a different mother.

We are told that Sarai was very beautiful, and that as she and Abram travelled on the journey God had set them out on, Abram often said she was his sister instead of his wife, because he was afraid that unknown strangers might kill him so they could take her. As you can imagine, this sometimes caused some problems.

Sarai's name changed in Genesis 17, along with Abram. God made a new covenant with them, and their new names reflected that new relationship. The new covenant included a promise for many descendants. But Sarah remained barren. When she was well past child-bearing age, 3 messengers from God arrived and reaffirmed God's promise of a son for Abraham and Sarah. As Sarah listened to these messengers from inside her tent, she laughed at the idea that she could bear a child at her advanced age.

But God's promise was fulfilled with the birth of their son, who they named Isaac, which means "laughter."

There is so much more to Sarah's story! Like many people in the Bible, she is sometimes very faithful, at times hold doubts about God's promises and faithfulness, and responds to the circumstances of her life in very human ways. If you'd like to read Sarah's story, it is recorded in Genesis, chapters 11–23.

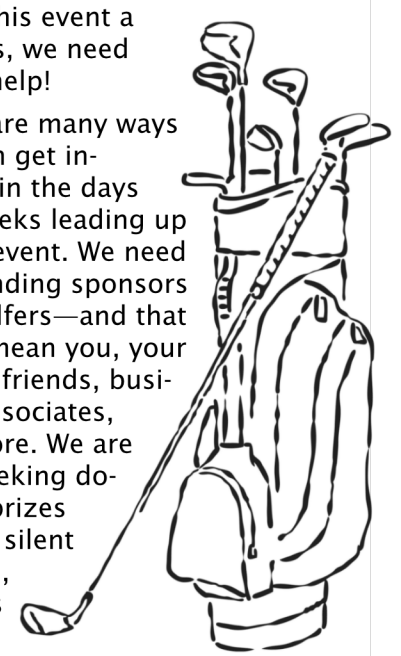
