### From Pastor Jen...

Dear Trinity Family,

As I shared in my sermon last month, I just read the book, *How to Break Up with Your Phone: The 30-Day Plan to Take Back Your Life* by Catherine Anne Price.

It has been a game changing read and even before I finished the 30-day plan, I had seen a difference.

I was able to see for myself that I would spend time on the phone, aimlessly, not learning, or doing things that helped me accomplish tasks, but rather as a way to zone out and disconnect from, well, pretty much anything around me.

Rather than seeking connection, and life in community, I would default to scrolling pretty much through any app I have, social media, news, email, weather, you name it.

And I discovered—something I guess I already knew to be true—but needed to relearn, that I was missing out on the world and the people around me.

Life in abundance was, is surrounding me, but I was opting to look away and disengage...to false connection and interaction through my phone.

I share all of this because, if as your pastor, one who preaches about abundant life in Jesus, and the life-giving abundance we receive when we are actively involved in this faith community—can fall into the trap of disconnecting, perhaps others of you have as well. And, well, that is not the life Jesus is calling us into.

The life Jesus is calling us into is one where we look at one another, truly see one another, and are present for and with one another. This life is where we set aside the things that distract us from seeing Jesus in this room, in our neighborhoods and larger community.

This life tends the wounds in our hearts and our souls. It comforts us in times of sorrow. It allows joy to show up and be shared in abundance. It offers us ample opportunities to connect truly and deeply with others.

## *Women of the Bible*

My dear siblings in Christ,

As we began last month with Sarah, we continue this month with Rachel, highlighting some of the women of the Bible in my monthly column. While I will highlight what we know from the biblical text, I will also be reflecting on the way I connect with their experiences as women of faith.

### **Rachel**

Rachel was a daughter of Laban, and was known as a woman of great beauty. Jacob, son of Isaac and Rebekah, who would become the father of the 12 men known as the heads of Israel's tribes, encountered Rachel when he journeyed to the land of his mother's family in search of a wife. Rachel's father Laban was Rebekah's brother, and Jacob's uncle.

Rachel was known to be a woman of great beauty, and Jacob quickly asked for her hand in marriage. Laban agreed to the marriage, but only if Jacob worked for him for seven years. At the end of the seven years, Laban tricked Jacob into marriage with his older daughter, Leah. He told Jacob it was not the custom in his country to give a younger daughter in marriage before an older one, but that if Jacob worked another seven years he could also have Rachel.

So Jacob worked another seven years, and then took Rachel as his wife.

Although Rachel was the wife that Jacob loved most dearly, it was Leah who was able to give him sons, while Rachel remained barren. Rachel prayed that God would give her a son, and after many years she gave birth to Joseph. Because

Joseph was the son of the wife he loved most, he was the favorite son of Jacob, who gifted him with a "robe with long sleeves", often referred to as a coat of many colors.

Rachel died in childbirth during the birth of Benjamin, who was the youngest of Jacob's 12 sons, and her only other child.

Rachel's life was not an easy one, especially during the years when she was barren and suffered the humiliation of being unable to fulfill her primary role of childbearing. She is most often honored for her diligence in prayer, and while she is known in Jewish and Christian traditions, she is also honored in Islam as wife of Jacob and mother of Joseph.

You can read her story in Genesis 29-35.

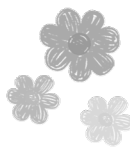
## *Redner's Save-A-Tape Update*

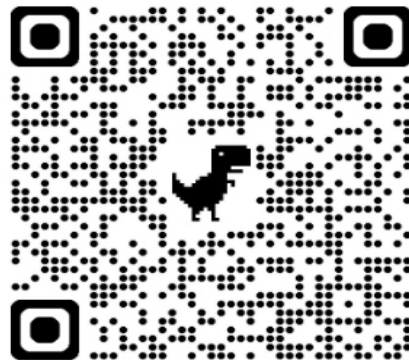
