[UPDATED] We are thrilled to share the exciting news that Pastor Jen has been named Bishop Elect of the North-eastern Pennsylvania (NEPA) Synod of the ELCA, following her election at the Synod Assembly on June 6, 2026. She will serve a six-year term beginning September 1st.

This is a profound honor for Pastor Jen, and for all of us at Trinity who have been blessed by her leadership and ministry. We offer her our heartfelt congratulations and our prayers as she prepares for this new and important call.

Pastor Jen's last Sunday with us will be August 16th, and her official installation as Bishop will take place October 31st (time and location TBD). Watch for a letter from Pastor Jen, sent this week by mail or email according to your newsletter preference, sharing more about these upcoming changes for Trinity.

Please keep Pastor Jen, Billy, and Trinity Lutheran Church in your prayers during this time of change and new beginnings. ▲

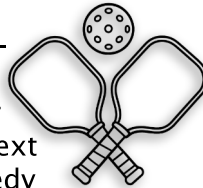
