## A New Call for Pastor Jen

We are thrilled to share the exciting news that Pastor Jen has been named Bishop Elect of the Northeastern Pennsylvania (NEPA) Synod of the ELCA, following her election at the Synod Assembly on June 6, 2026. She will serve a six-year term beginning September 1st.



This is a profound honor for Pastor Jen, and for all of us at Trinity who have been blessed by her leadership and ministry. We offer her our heartfelt congratulations and our prayers as she prepares for this new and important call.

As Bishop Elect, Pastor Jen will be transitioning out of her role as Lead Pastor. What that transition looks like for Trinity—and the exciting journey of calling new pastoral leadership—will unfold in the months ahead. Some additional details were shared in a letter you received in June from Pastor Jen and are included in her message below.

Please keep Pastor Jen, Billy, and Trinity Lutheran Church in your prayers during this time of change and new beginnings. ▲

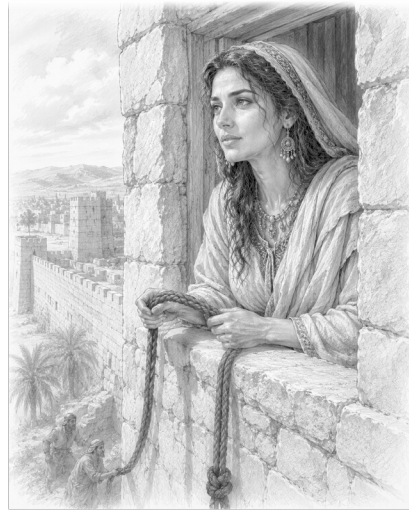

## From Pastor Eileen...

### Women of the Bible - Rahab

When Rahab's name is mentioned, if she is recognized at all she is usually remembered as "a harlot" mentioned in the book of Joshua.

It is entirely possible that Rahab worked as a prostitute since there were few other ways a woman could earn money if her family depended on her for support. But there are other significant things about Rahab for us to know. She lived in the town of Jerico, in a house that bordered on the city wall, near the entrance gate. It's possible that she also worked as an innkeeper, providing rooms to travelers.

As Israel was preparing to mount an attack on Jerico as their entrance into the land they believed God had promised to them, Joshua sent 2 spies to scout the city. When they entered the city, they approached Rahab's house. She gave them a room for the night. But their presence had been detected, and soldiers of the king came to her house looking for them. The people of Jerico had heard of God's wondrous deeds done on behalf of the people of Israel and were afraid of them. So she hid them on her roof, protecting them from capture, because, as she told them, "The Lord your God is indeed God in heaven above and on earth below."

The next morning, Rahab helped them leave the city undetected, but had them

promise that when Israel attacked Jerico, they would spare her life and the lives of her family. The soldiers promised to do so but told her she needed to gather her family in her house and tie a crimson cord at the window where she helped them to freedom as a sign to them.

Her faith and her courage allowed the Israelite spies to safely return home, and her family was spared when Israel attacked.

Biblical scholars tell us that Rahab has an even deeper connection to our faith history. She was the mother of Boaz, who later became Ruth's husband. Ruth and Boaz were the great-grandparents of King David.

Rahab is just one example, out of many, of the diverse people of faith who are woven into the story of God's ongoing interaction with humanity. You can read Rahab's story in the book of Joshua, chapter 2.
